Mount Vernon District RECenter

- 25-meter heated indoor pool with poolside spa
- Year-round indoor ice arena
- Beach area with play features
- Locker rooms with showers and sauna
- Fitness center with Cybex VR2 equipment
- Room rentals for birthday parties and special events



Lee District RECenter

6601 Telegraph Road

- 50-meter heated indoor pool, Superslide, 3 diving boards
- Gym with regulation size basketball court, converts to 1/2 courts or volleyball, 1/10 mi track, boxing equipment
- Locker rooms with showers and sauna
- Fitness center with cardio equipment, free weights, cycles
- Outdoors: 4 lighted tennis courts, "sprayground", 4 basketball courts, playing fields, playground, and more!
